Household batteries are considered hazardous waste and must not be thrown in the trash. To promote the proper recycling and disposal of batteries, the City has established a number of convenient drop-off sites for residents. Please call for hours of operation.

Lead-acid batteries (from a car, motorcycle, etc.) and large batteries from universal power supplies are not accepted at the locations listed below and must be brought to Lompoc's Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility (HHWCF). Participants of the HHWCF must call to make an appointment (875-8024) one day in advance.
