SUBJECT: City Council Consideration Of A Revised Storm Water Management Program for the City of Lompoc

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council consider the attached Storm Water Management Program (SWMP) and cover letter, direct staff to make any desired changes, and direct staff to submit the SWMP to the Regional Water Quality Board, Central Coast Region (RWQCB)

BACKGROUND:

The City of Lompoc submitted its SWMP to the RWQCB on March 10, 2003, as required. After undertaking three revisions at the direction of the RWQCB staff, the City received a letter dated February 15, 2008, which imposed new permit requirements beyond those included in the State Water Quality Control Board's General Permit for the Discharge of Storm Water from Small MS4s or those previously identified by RWQCB Staff. A deadline of April 11, 2008, was given to the City for submittal of a revised SWMP addressing the new requirements. The City's SWMP was revised and submitted on April 10, 2008, and was considered by the City Council at its April 15, 2008 meeting.

DISCUSSION:

On May 1, 2008 the City received a letter from the RWQCB's staff stipulating further required changes to the City's SWMP. City staff has reviewed these additional requirements and revised the City's SWMP to address those items which were found to be acceptable. Those items which were not found to be appropriate for inclusion in the City's SWMP have not been made. In some cases, alternative measures, designed to reduce pollutants in storm water and appropriate for implementation in Lompoc, have been included in Lompoc's SWMP, instead of those required by the RWQCB's staff.
