Enclosed please find a petition for review and statement of points and authorities in support of the City of Lompoc's (City) petition for review related to certain provisions of Resolution No. R3-2008-0071 and the Table of Required Revisions attached thereto. Resolution No. R3-2008-0071 approves the City's Storm Water Management Program (SWMP), but requires the City to amend the SWMP no later than February 28, 2009, as provided in the Table of Required Revisions. In particular, the City challenges Required Revision Nos. 16, 17, 18, and 20.

The City respectfully requests that the State Water Board place the petition for review in abeyance pursuant to title 23, section 2050.5(d) of the California Code of Regulations. The City reserves the right to file a more detailed statement of points and authorities in support of the petition, at such time that the State Water Board considers the issues present in the petition.
