

RECYCLED WATER IS HERE!

The City of Lompoc now has recycled water available for use in grading & construction.

Where can I use recycled water? In grading of new commercial, industrial, multi-family and subdivision projects & in highway construction.



What can recycled water be used for?

- Compaction of soil, asphalt and backfill, away from potable water lines
- Concrete mixing & grinding, away from City streets and alleys
- On-site dust control
- Other approved uses, as detailed in City of Lompoc's Recycled Water Permit

Are there fees for recycled water? Yes, fees will be calculated at the time of application.

How do I get recycled water?

- Complete a Recycled Water Permit Application at the Lompoc Regional Wastewater Reclamation Plant (LRWRP) located at [1801 W. Central Avenue, Lompoc or The City of Lompoc.](#)

- Receive required recycled water use training at the LRWRP.
- Obtain a water truck approved for use with recycled water & ensuring it has required signage. City does not deliver.
- Collect the recycled water from the LRWRP's recycled water dispensing unit. LRWRP Staff will supervise recycled water collection.
- An inspection to verify proper recycled water use is required.
- Return unused recycled water to the wastewater plant.
